**Export Controls Compliance and Penalties**

EAR & ITAR Export Seminar

If the acronyms OFAC, BIS, EAR, ITAR, DDTC are not familiar to you as a U.S. exporter, be concerned about compliance and get ready to pay monetary penalties. Mr. Peter Quinter has 20 years experience in export compliance, and has represented persons and companies who have been subjects of criminal and civil investigations for export violations.
